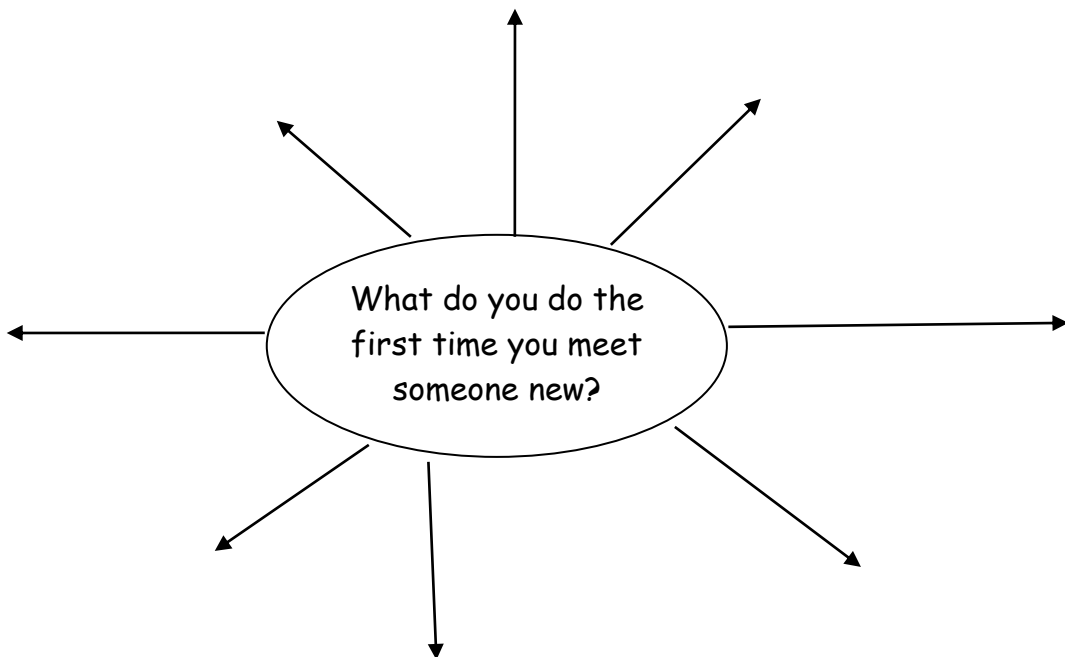

## Rules for meeting people at school

- a. Try and make eye contact with the person you want to talk to.

- c. Wait for them to look at you.
- d. Smile and look friendly.
- e. Wait for them to say "hello" to you.
- f. Keep looking at their eyes.
- g. Ask them what their name is.
- h. Keep looking at their eyes and listen to what they say.
- i. Ask them a question about themselves.
